The average student retention rate from Fall 2018 to Summer 2023 is 35.8%.

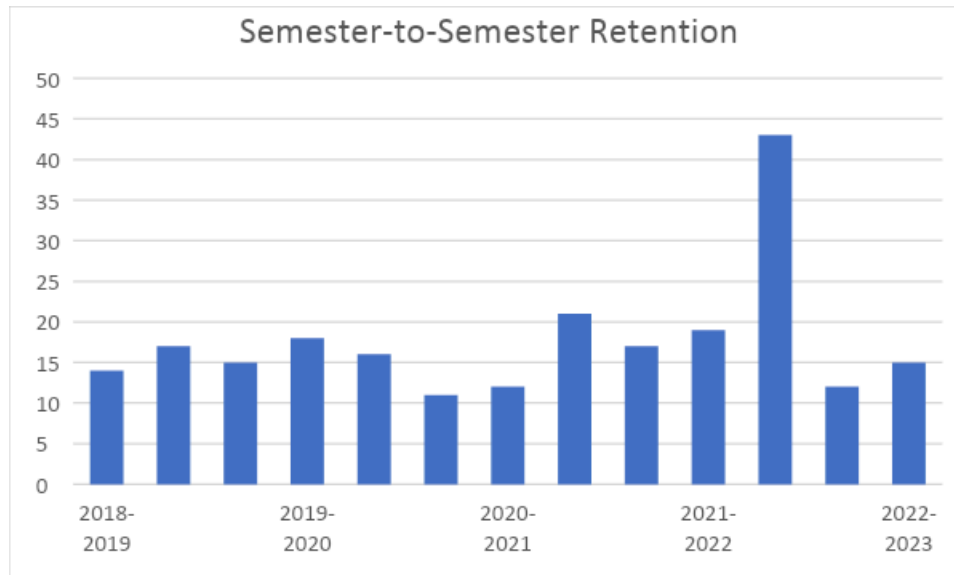

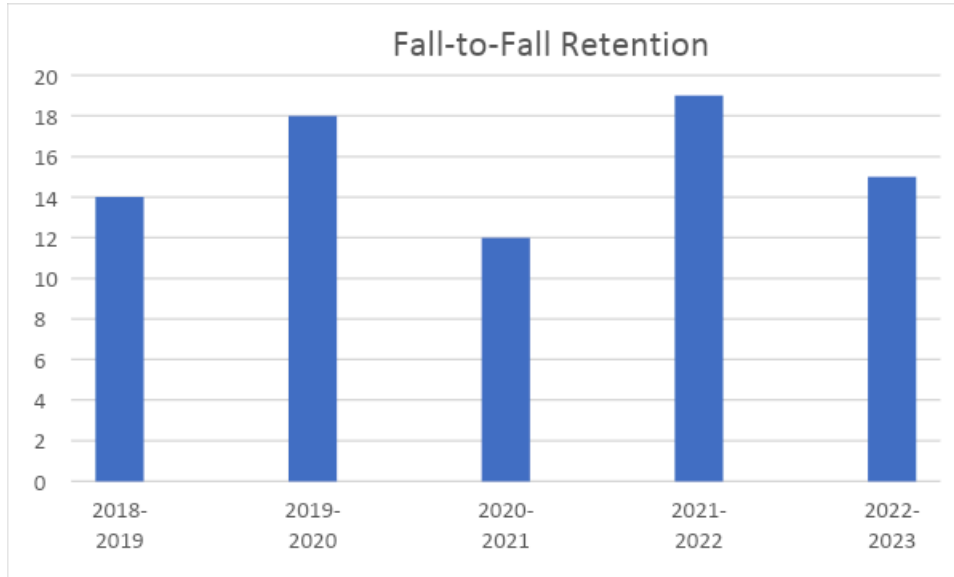

3. Objective	Students will successfully complete the coursework, which in turn will increase retention
4. Threshold of Acceptability	Minimum value = 20%
5. Rationale	The success rate from AY 2018-2022 with n=95 students
6. Goal	Target value = 30%
7. Rationale	Retention rate n=95 students from AY 2018-2019 to AY2022-2023
8. Outcome	AY success rate = 35.8% from institutional data; Given that 35.8% > 30%, <i>this objective is met</i>

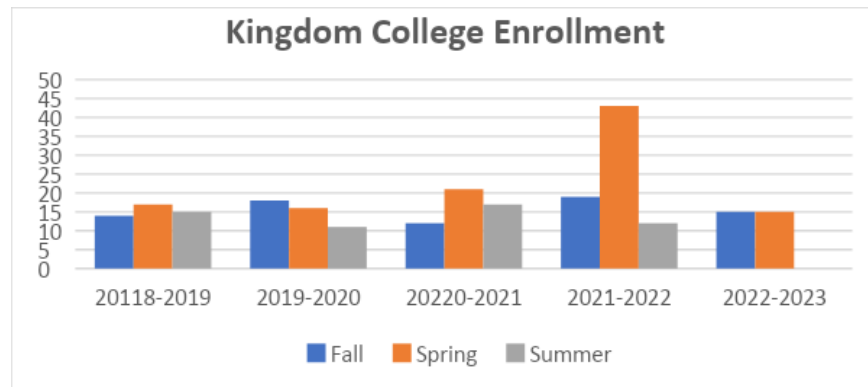
The average enrollment from Fall 2018 through Spring 2023 is 17 students.

6. Goal	Target value = 20% over 4 years
7. Rationale	Success rate n=95 students from AY 2018-2019 to 2021-2022
8. Outcome	AY success rate = 24% from institutional data; Given that 24% > 20%, <i>this objective is met</i>

General Studies Course Success Rates

From Fall 2018 through Summer 2023, 31 general studies courses were taken by Kingdom College students. Based on Kingdom College General Education Core Competencies, all course grade averages were above the benchmark of 60% and 70% or more mastery. The average of all General Education Core Competency course grades is 87%.

6. Goal	Target value = 70%
7. Rationale	Success rate n=31 courses from AY 2018-2019 to 2021-2023
8. Outcome	AY success rate = 86% from institutional data; Given that 87% > 70%, <i>this objective is met</i>

Student surveys are sent to all students near the end of each semester. The average return rate of responses is 41%.

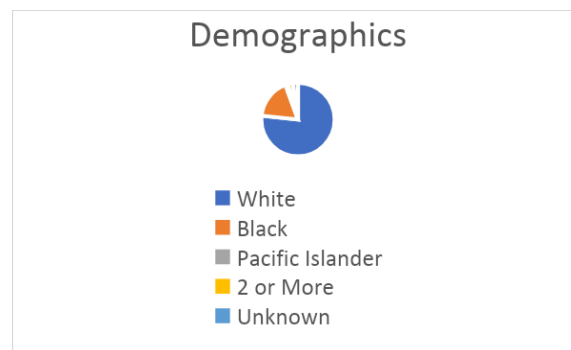
